Brief Description of Duckworth Worcestershire Trust and WRE

The Duckworth Worcestershire Trust, a registered charity, was established in 1998 by the former chairman of Worcester Heat Systems, Mr Cecil Duckworth.

We are dedicated to the conservation, protection and enhancement of the natural and built environments for the people of Worcestershire. We also aim to relieve poverty amongst those who are disadvantaged with an equal opportunities policy in place.

Worcestershire Resource Exchange is a community project focusing on art and reuse, which offers a scrap store full of exciting and unusual materials, rescued from local industry with amazing potential for creative reuse. These provide inspirational and affordable resources whilst reducing landfill. Along side the scrap store there is a well stocked art and craft shop, an art reference library, an artist database, an art workshop space which can be hired, a community repaint scheme, refurbished bicycle shop and a wood recycling store. Membership is necessary for the scrap store but members of the public are welcome to come and look around. Non members can buy from the craft shop, bicycle store, repaint and wood store.

Job Description

To create scrap resource packs, to a saleable standard & of consistent quality, from WRE stock. Packs will be sold on & off site as the 'WREmade' branded product. To work with a team of pack creators on a fortnightly basis, up keeping shop stock & making 'WREmade' packs to order by preparing materials, picking and packing.

Training and requirements

We are looking for enthusiastic individuals who enjoy working within a team whilst doing repetitive work. Candidates must ideally have an eye for detail for quality control, be visually aware with a good colour sense and have the dexterity to handle and pack small scrap items into bagged packs.

Following a simple induction of the building and necessary house keeping and welfare; full training will be given.

A CRB enhanced disclosure check is required as volunteers maybe working with vulnerable adults and under 18's.

Volunteers will be responsible to WRE Project Staff.
